TIRE MAINTENANCE & SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Any tire, no matter how well constructed, may fail in use as a result of punctures, impact damage, improper inflation, overloading, or other conditions resulting from use or misuse. Tire failure may create a risk of property damage, serious personal injury.



SAFETY INFORMATION

Serious personal injury or death may result from a tire failure. Many tire failures are preceded by vibration, bumps, bulges or irregular wear. If a vibration occurs while driving your vehicle or you notice a bump, bulge or irregular wear, have your tires and vehicle checked by a qualified service professional immediately.

TIRE PRESSURE

Proper inflation pressure is essential for tires to operate effectively and perform as intended. Tires carry the vehicle, passenger, and cargo loads and transmit the braking, acceleration, and turning forces. The vehicle manufacturer recommends the inflation pressures for the tires mounted on your vehicle. The proper inflation pressure is molded on the sidewall of each tire.

OWNER'S OBLIGATIONS

To make an eligible claim under this Limited Warranty, the owner must present a claim with the actual tire to the dealer where it was originally purchased. Original proof of purchase must be presented. Owner will be required to provide information listed on TBB Tires Inc.'s Adjustment Form and sign the form. Owner is responsible for paying all applicable taxes set forth under this Limited Warranty. Owner is also responsible for paying local tire disposal fees and any parts or service regardless of mileage or months of service. This includes payment for tire rotation, alignment, towing, road service, valve stems and tire repair. Owner is responsible for maintaining proper tire air pressure and for proper maintenance of the tire.

TIRE REGISTRATION

The registration of TBB and Associated brand tires is an important safety precaution. Registration will allow TBB Tires Inc. to notify the owner in the event of a product return program. Tire registration may be completed online at www.tbbtires.com (U.S.A.).

WARRANTY COVERAGE

Free Adjustment I:

A TBB or Associated brand tire will be accepted for warranty only within the first 2/32 inch of treadwear or 36 months from the date of original purchase (proof of purchase required), whichever comes first, due to a ride disturbance complaint only (Out of Round). A pro-rated amount (excluding FET) of the remaining usable tread (subtract the original new tire tread depth with 2/32 inch and used tread depth) will be credited to owner towards future purchase. Credit will be determined by multiplying the percentage of the remaining usable tread with the Original Purchase Price. Service charges may apply.

Free Adjustment II:

Should a TBB or Associated brand tire becomes unserviceable due to defects in material and workmanship prior to the wearing down to the 2/32inch of the original usable tread (subtract the original new tire tread depth with 2/32 inch), or 36 months from the date of original purchase (proof of purchase required), whichever comes first, a pro-rated amount (excluding FET) will be credited to owner towards future purchase. Credit will be determined by multiplying the percentage of the remaining usable tread with the Original Purchase Price. Service charges may apply.



SAFETY INFORMATION

Driving with improper inflated tires is dangerous.

- Under inflation could cause excessive heat build-up and internal structural damage.
- Over inflation makes it more likely for the tire to be cut, punctured, or broken by sudden impact.

The above situations can cause tire failures, even at a later time, which could lead to serious personal injury or death. Consult the vehicle owner's manual for the recommended inflation pressures. The proper inflation pressure of the tire is molded on the sidewall of each tire.



SAFETY INFORMATION

Inflating an unsecured tire is dangerous. If it blowout occurs, it could be hurled into the air with explosive force resulting in serious personal injury or death. Never inflate a tire unless it is secured to the vehicle or a tire mounting device.



SAFETY INFORMATION

Driving your vehicle in an overloaded condition is extremely dangerous. Overloading could cause excessive tire heat build-up and internal structural damage. This can cause a tire failure, even at a later time, which could lead to serious personal injury or even death. Consult the vehicle's owners manual for the recommended vehicle load limits and loading recommendations. The maximum load capacity of the tire is molded on the sidewall of each tire.



SAFETY INFORMATION

Driving on damaged tire is dangerous. A damaged tire can suddenly fail causing serious personal injury or even death. Have your tires regularly inspected by a qualified service professional.



SAFETY INFORMATION

Driving at high speed is dangerous and can cause an accident, resulting in serious personal injury or even death. Always operate your vehicle within the lawful speed limit. The maximum speed limit of the tire is molded on the sidewall of each tire.

ADDITIONAL EXCLUSIONS

Tires submitted for ride disturbance complaints after 2/32 inch of treadwear (Out of Round).

Tires on vehicles registered or operated outside of the United States.

Tires not sold in the United States by TBB Tires Inc.

Tires branded by TBB Tires Inc. to note special classification at time of purchase, such as "NA" (non-adjustable), or tires altered by notching or buffing.

Improper storage.

This Limited Warranty is in addition to and/or may be limited by any other applicable written warranty you may have received from TBB Tires Inc.

WHAT IS NOT COVERED

This Limited Warranty does not cover the following:

3. Weather/ozone cracking after 3 years from date of tire manufacture.
4. Ride disturbance or vibration after 2/32 inch of tread wear use.
5. Tires with sealant, balance, or other filler material that was not originally applied or inserted by the tire manufacturer.
6. Tires purchased as used.
7. Tires purchased and normally used outside the United States.
10. The cost of applicable federal, state, and local taxes.
11. Original equipment tires on new vehicles.
12. Failure to follow any of the safety and maintenance recommendations or warnings contained in this manual.

This Limited Warranty is in addition to and/or may be limited by any other applicable written warranty you may have received from TBB Tires Inc.



SAFETY INFORMATION

Spinning a tire under slippery conditions can be dangerous. A spinning tire is capable of structural disintegration with explosive force. Under some conditions, a tire may be spinning at a speed twice that shown on the speedometer. This could cause serious personal injury or even death to a bystander or passenger.



SAFETY INFORMATION

Driving your vehicle with an improper mix of tires is dangerous. Your vehicle's handling characteristics can be affected. You could have an accident resulting in serious personal injury or even death. Consult your vehicle owner's manual or a qualified tire service professional for proper tire replacement.

LIMITED WARRANTY

ELIGIBILITY

Congratulations on your recent tire purchase from TBB Tires Inc. or Associated brand dealers. This Limited Warranty covers new TBB and Associated brand all steel radial truck tires.

This Limited Warranty only applies to the tire's original purchaser, and is valid only if all of the following apply:

- The tire was purchased after January 1, 2011.
- The tire was produced after March 1, 2010 (DOT serial 1010 or later).
- The tire is a size and speed rating equivalent to that specified by the vehicle manufacturer.
- The tire has been used only on the vehicle on which it was originally installed.

This Limited Warranty is in addition to and/or may be limited by any other applicable written warranty you may have received from TBB Tires Inc.

WHAT IS NOT COVERED

This Limited Warranty does not cover the following:

1. Tire damage or irregular wear due to:
 - A. Road hazards, including, without limitation: Puncture, cut, impact break, stone drill, bruise, bulge, snag, etc.
 - B. Improper use or operation, including, without limitation: Improper inflation pressure, overloading, tire/wheel spinning, use of an improper wheel, tire chain damage, misuse, misapplication, negligence, tire alteration, or for racing or competition purposes.
 - C. Insufficient or improper maintenance, including, without limitation: Failure to rotate tires as recommended, wheel misalignment, worn suspension components, improper tire mounting or demounting, tire/wheel assembly imbalance, or other vehicle conditions, defects, or Characteristics.
 - D. Contamination or degradation by petroleum products or other chemicals, fire or other externally generated heat, or water or other material trapped inside the tire during mounting or inflation.
 - E. Improper repair. Improper repair voids this Limited Warranty.
2. Rapid tread wear or wear-out is not covered under this Limited Warranty.
